## OFFICIAL RULES

1. Pumpkins must be grown, cared for, and entered by the Weigh-Off contestant.
2. A contestant may enter only one pumpkin per family or household.
3. Pumpkins that have be weighed at other Weigh-Off contests are not eligible.
4. Pumpkin must be 100% of the following colors or color combinations of orange, red, yellow & salmon.
5. The pumpkin must be sound, healthy, undamaged, free of rot, holes, cracks, chemical (fungicides) residue or serious soft spots.
6. The vine must be trimmed to one inch from the stem of the fruit.
7. In the event of a tie, the prize money for those two places will be added together and divided equally between the two entries.
8. To be eligible for GPC prize money, all pumpkins must be weighed without the use of tarps or other carrying devices.
9. The 1st place pumpkin becomes the property of Uesugi Farms Pumpkin Patch. 2nd-20th place pumpkins are eligible for Uesugi Farms buy back program, if chosen, at the following prices: 1,000 lbs. + = \$1 per lb., 500-999 lbs. = \$0.50 per lb., and 0-499 lbs. = \$0.35 per lb. Only 2 pumpkins will be selected. Contestants may claim their seeds on 10/29/16.
10. Decisions of the judges are final in all cases.

## WORLD RECORD BREAKER

### \$30,000 PRIZE:

The winner will receive \$7.00 per pound upon completion of our weigh-off. If the winner breaks the world record – and holds it for the remainder of the 2014 season – he or she will receive an additional prize to bring their total winnings to \$30,000 on November 1<sup>st</sup>. Example: a 2,000-pound pumpkin would receive \$14,000 at the completion of our competition (2,000 pounds x \$7 per pound = \$14,000) plus an additional \$16,000 on November 1<sup>st</sup> for a total of \$30,000.

## AGRICULTURAL SCHOLARSHIP

In addition to the prize money presented to the winners, Uesugi Farms will donate the following amounts to the Michael Aiello Memorial Agricultural Scholarship Fund in Morgan Hill, CA:

- \$1 per pound for 1st place winner**
- \$.50 per pound for 2nd place winner**
- \$.25 per pound for 3rd place winner**

## DELIVERY OF ENTRIES

Growers are responsible for bringing their pumpkins to the Weigh-Off site, Uesugi Farms Pumpkin Patch, between 9:00 and 11:00 am on Saturday, October 8, 2016. Deliveries after 11am will not be eligible to enter. Weigh-Off staff will handle all entries with care and transport pumpkins to the scales with a forklift and a specially-designed pumpkin strap that will not damage the fruit.
